## 2016-2017 OIC of Washington Logo Design Contest Official Rules

#### INTRODUCTION:

The OIC of Washington Logo Design Contest (the "Contest") gives participants the opportunity to design a LOGO for OIC of Washington. By participating in the contest, the artist accepts and agrees to comply with the Official Rules.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Contest is open to residents of Adams, Benton, Chelan, Douglas, Franklin, Grant, Kittitas, Skagit and Yakima counties, as well as OIC board, staff, participants and volunteers. If you are under the age of 18, your parent/guardian must sign the consent block on the Official Entry Form, to ensure you have your parent or legal guardian's permission.

#### **ENTRY:**

To enter the Contest, eligible participants must:

- 1. Download and complete the Official Entry Form. - 2. Create a logo!
- Convert the design into a usable web version and a scalable vector, print quality version of the logo. The logo
  must adapt well to electronic and print media, to reproduction on small and large surfaces, and to use in color
  or in grayscale.
- 4. Email your completed Official Entry Form and your design logo to ddennis@yvoic.org.

#### **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:**

You must submit your design and completed entry form by 11:59pm PST on January 31, 2017.

**LOOK AND FEEL GUIDELINES:** Your design should be dynamic, unique, creative, and incorporate the full name "OIC of Washington." The logo may incorporate other imagery or abstract symbols which represent the mission of OIC of Washington so long as the name is included somewhere in the logo. OIC of Washington's mission is to "help in the elimination of unemployment, poverty and illiteracy so that people of all colors and creeds can live their lives with greater human dignity." OIC addresses this mission by providing services in emergency food assistance, home weatherization, youth education and employment training, migrant seasonal farmworker employment training, community services, financial planning, and after school youth programs.

**FORMATTING:** For purposes of submission, please submit the design in .png, .jpg or as a .pdf file (less than 10MB). If the logo incorporates non-standard fonts, you must be able to provide us with the font should your logo be selected. If you are chosen as a winner, you MUST be able to provide a high-resolution vector file.

#### **PRIZE:** Winner will receive:

- 1. One(1) \$200 Visa Gift Card; and,
- 2. Artistic credit for your winning design on OIC of Washington's web site, print and social media. The winning design will be used as the Official Logo for OIC of Washington including promotional items, business letterhead and business cards, and on our website as well as social media platforms and other advertisements.

All entry designs will be screened and those that comply with the Official Contest Rules and have met the guidelines and specifications will be judged by a committee made up of agency staff and board members.
